BONNEAUVILLE BOROUGH COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 445-20

AMENDING BOROUGH OF BONNEAUVILLE DEVELOPER'S SPECIFICATIONS SECTION 01010 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS, PART 1 GENERAL SUBSECTION 1.09 MUNICIPAL POTABLE WATER WELL CAPACITY REQUIREMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Bonneauville Developers Specifications subsection 1.09 entitled Municipal Potable Waters Well Capacity Requirement (A) the Borough will not accept a municipal potable water well with a permitted capacity of less than 30 gpm. Well capacity shall be based on continuous operation over a one year period.

WHEREAS, Council desires to amend this subsection in order to allow a developer of one or up to three lots an option in lieu of providing a water well permitted with a capacity of more than 30 gpm pay unto the Borough a fee of Five Thousand 00/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars, per lot. Said fee shall be provided to the Borough in lieu of the developer providing a water well in order to develop and shall go into a fund generated towards improvement and/or development of existing or future municipal water wells.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Council amends Bonneauville Developer's Specification Section 01010 General Requirement Part 1 – General Requirements, General subsection 109 Municipal Potable Water Well Capacity Requirement (A) to include the following:

(i) "a developer of one or up to three lots shall have the option in lieu of providing a water well permitted with a capacity of more than 30 gpm to pay unto the Borough a fee of Five Thousand 00/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars, per lot. Said fee shall be provided to the Borough and shall go into a fund generated towards improvement and/or development of existing or future municipal water wells.
