ORDINANCE Consideration for adoption: Amending the code of the Borough of Bonneauville Article IV, Additional Requirements of Specific Uses 225-39(D) (10) Pets, Keeping of. Subsection (d) thereof. 1. 2.

Amount for the Residential Chicken permit.

Looking at the current Vehicle code, Solicitor Erb believes the council's concerns are already addressed pursuant to Article II Storage of Motor Vehicles §140-10. Under this section, public or private grounds restrict as unlawful the maintenance of a motor vehicle that does not have a current license or registration or is unable to move on its own power. Under §140-11, it allows for storage of the above only upon the owner obtaining a permit from the borough, and under §140-12 allows for inspection; §140-13, remedy; §140-14, hearing before council, and ultimately §140-15, violation and penalties.

NEW BUSINESS Borough Website, Adams County will no longer allow piggybacking off of their website, CCAP will no longer be continuing their web program. The County will be switching to Revise, and the current website will no longer work as of 12/31/2026. The Secretary obtained two quotes. 1. Muni-Link Web Presence \$2,160 annually, set up fee \$725
2. Revise \$2,400 annually, set up fee \$6,500 to create.
